

Evaluating Bitcoins Long-Term Survivability Through Technical Structure, Decentralization, Market Psychology, and Institutional Dynamics

Bitcoin continues to experience upward pressure despite ongoing geopolitical tensions, such as the stalled peace negotiations between the United States and Iran and recent attacks on vessels in the Strait of Hormuz. Statements from U.S. defense officials and former President Trump's expressed willingness to negotiate have temporarily eased uncertainties. The U.S. government appears reluctant to engage in prolonged military conflict, especially with midterm elections approaching, contributing to a decline in oil prices and overall market stabilization. Consequently, Bitcoin and the Nasdaq index have maintained strong upward momentum.

A primary driver of Bitcoin's recent gains is the influx of institutional investment through spot exchange-traded funds (ETFs). Over several consecutive days, significant capital inflows have been recorded, with large-scale purchases by institutional investors persisting. Ethereum spot ETFs have similarly attracted continuous inflows, signaling a renewed institutional interest in the cryptocurrency market. Weekly crypto fund inflows have been sustained for multiple weeks, and BlackRock's spot ETF ranks highly among all ETFs, reflecting robust demand. Additionally, Bitcoin-related investment vehicles such as the Strategy stock have nearly doubled in value within a month, further supporting the recovery of institutional supply.

Major market participants like Bitmain have demonstrated a clear commitment to long-term holding by acquiring large quantities of Ethereum and expanding staking activities. This approach indicates a strategy focused on accumulation and network participation rather than short-term selling. One of the most critical regulatory developments is the Clarity Act, which has advanced through confidential negotiations in the Senate and recently released a final draft, increasing the likelihood of passage. Ripple's CEO has indicated that the bill's approval is imminent, although unresolved debates surrounding stablecoins may delay finalization.

The tokenization market is gaining traction within traditional U.S. financial institutions. The New York Stock Exchange has proposed regulatory amendments to permit trading of tokenized securities, and

the Depository Trust & Clearing Corporation plans to launch tokenized securities services shortly. Prominent Wall Street asset managers are introducing tokenized funds and implementing on-chain cash management systems, accelerating the digital transformation of finance. BlackRock's tokenized fund has shown consistent growth over several weeks, reflecting the expanding presence of tokenization in the financial sector. Furthermore, Solana-based networks are favored within U.S. finance, with collaborations such as those between Western Union and Google Cloud to build digital infrastructure, indicating rapid growth in tokenization and stablecoin ecosystems.

The proliferation of artificial intelligence (AI) innovations and financial AI agents is also driving demand for stablecoins. As AI agents automate financial operations, stablecoins are becoming essential as digital payment instruments within the evolving digital economy. Despite short-term market adjustments and waning retail interest, the crypto market is establishing a foundation for long-term growth through expanded infrastructure by Wall Street and innovative companies, alongside the recovery of institutional supply.

Open interest in Bitcoin futures has risen since April, suggesting a restoration of market participation. On-chain data reveals a steady increase in whale wallets holding more than ten Bitcoins, while smaller retail investors exhibit selling behavior, indicating a shift in market dynamics. Long-term holders transitioning to net buyers further signal accumulation. Technical analysis shows Bitcoin breaking through a key resistance level near \$79,000, confirming a short-term momentum shift, though the relative strength index (RSI) entering overbought territory suggests the possibility of a temporary correction. The rise in Bitcoin dominance over altcoins indicates capital concentration in Bitcoin, favoring focused investment in the short term.

Fiscal expansion by the U.S. Treasury and liquidity provision ahead of midterm elections have positively influenced markets despite low prospects for interest rate cuts. Ultimately, the trajectory of the U.S.-Iran conflict and the final resolution of the Clarity Act remain pivotal variables for the Bitcoin market. Resolution of these issues could significantly strengthen Bitcoin's upward momentum.

Considering these complex factors, Bitcoin and the broader crypto market exhibit enhanced medium- to long-term growth potential, supported by institutional supply recovery, digital transformation within traditional finance, and advances in AI technology, despite geopolitical and regulatory

uncertainties.

For individual investors, this implies that reacting solely to short-term volatility may be less effective than attentively monitoring institutional flows, regulatory developments, and technological progress. Looking ahead, the convergence of tokenization, stablecoins, and AI-driven financial tools is poised to become a central growth engine, suggesting that diversified, long-term strategies aligned with these trends will be increasingly important. This evolution underscores crypto's transformation from a speculative asset class to a foundational component of financial innovation.

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
